Application to the master program in Food Technology and Safety

Applications to the master program in Food Technology and Safety are open to the *campus* of Angra do Heroísmo.

1. Vacancies

1.1. Phase 1 – 20.

1.2. Phase 2 – vacancies remaining from phase 1.

1.3. Phase 3 – vacancies remaining from phase 2.

2. Application requirements

You may apply to this master program if:

a) you have a license degree in Food Sciences, Agrarian Sciences, Nutrition Sciences, Biotechnology, Biological Sciences or related fields of study, or other legally equivalent qualifications;

b) you have an academic, scientific and professional curriculum that the Scientific Council of the University considers adequate to this master and that demonstrates your large experience in this field of studies.

3. Application process

3.1. Application periods

3.1.1. phase 1

- **June 5 to July 16** – Application and verification of admission
- **Up to July 27** – Applications' ranking and approval
- **August 1 to 6** – Enrollment and registration

3.1.2. phase 2 (for remaining vacancies only)

- **July 17 to September 5** – Application and verification of admission
- **Up to September 16** – Applications' ranking and approval
- **September 20 to 25** – Enrollment and registration



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3.1.3. phase 3 (only for remaining vacancies only)

- **September 6 to 27** – Application and verification of admission
- **Up to October 3** – Applications' ranking and approval
- **October 8 to 10** – Enrollment and registration

3.2. Application is online at <http://servicosonline.uac.pt>, at “applications”. The following documents are required:

a) Application form dully filled in;

b) Detailed CV (enough to allow good evaluation of the applicant's requirements and merits) with proof documents attached;

c) Official certificates of qualifications, indicating final grade and specific course grades (students from the University of the Azores are only required to attach the certificate of conclusion with final grade).

3.3. The Academic Services may ask for the originals of the documents attached to the form.

3.4. Certificates from foreign institutions not issued in Spanish, French or English must be translated and duly authenticated.

4. Application fee and Tuition

4.1. Application fee is 70 € (nonrefundable in case of withdrawal). Payment may be done by ATM, according to information on the application form, or at the University treasury services in Ponta Delgada or Angra do Heroísmo, during the application period.

4.2. Applicants living abroad may pay by wire transfer or credit card. All information shall be asked to queroestudar@uac.pt.

5. Admission and ranking

5.1. Applications will be ranked according to the following criteria:

- a) Academic history, namely the fields of study, license degree grades and other qualification (70%);
- b) Scientific curricula, namely experience in research and publications (20%);
- c) Professional experience (10%).

5.2. The evaluation of the above will be done according to attachment 1.



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5.3. If the number of applications is under the number of vacancies, those may be ranked in alphabetical order only.

6. Publication of results

6.1. Applications' results will be disclosed at our official web page (www.uac.pt).

6.2. Any complaints must be presented up to three days after the publication of results, using the form available at <http://servicosonline.uac.pt>.

6.3. The result of the analysis of the complaints will also be disclosed at www.uac.pt

7. Enrollment and registration

Enrollment and registration are done at the Academic Services on the dates indicated before.

Students not living in S. Miguel or Terceira may do it by electronic means during the same period. All information shall be asked to queroestudar@uac.pt.

8. Classes' start

Classes start on October 1st, 2018, and follow the academic calendar 2018-2019.
